THE PORTS REGULATOR OF SOUTH AFRICA'S ANNOUNCEMENT OF RECORD OF DECISION ON THE NATIONAL PORTS AUTHORITY TARIFF

APPLICATION: 2026/27 – 2028/29

The Ports Regulator is a Schedule 3A entity established in terms of section 29 of the National Ports Act, Act 12 of 2005 reporting to the Minister of Transport. It is an Independent Economic Regulator of South Africa's commercial ports owned, managed and controlled by the National Ports Authority, a division of Transnet SOC. The Ports Regulator is a Schedule 3A entity reporting to the Minister of Transport.

The Ports Regulator's main functions are to:

- exercise economic regulation of the ports system in line with government's strategic objectives;
- promote equity of access to ports and to facilities and services provided in ports; and
- monitor the activities of the Authority to ensure that it performs its functions in accordance with the Act.

On August 1, 2025, the National Ports Authority submitted its Tariff Application for the period covering 2026/27 to 2028/29. After extensive stakeholder engagements and considering written submissions from stakeholders, the Ports Regulator cordially invites port users, stakeholders, and members of the media to attend the Record of Decision Announcement regarding the National Ports Authority's Tariff Application for the period 2026/27 to 2028/29.
